Submission Tips

Published monthly, *PSC* is the authoritative source of information on public safety communications worldwide. We seek articles of direct relevance to comm center managers and directors, telecommunicators, IT personnel and engineers, specifically looking for accurate, detailed features (approximately 2,400 to 3,000 words) on comm center operations, regulatory issues and technical topics; comprehensive analysis of new procedures, technology and products; concise reporting of association and industry news; and provocative commentaries (approximately 850 words). We seek practical, hands-on articles drawn from real-world examples. **We do not accept simultaneous submissions—or poetry.** Consider using a lessons learned, what we did right or how-to approach. You can also ask the editor about direction, tone, style, etc.

A picture is worth a thousand words: We accept prints, slides and digital formats (jpg, TIF or EPS). We require 300 dpi resolution at the size intended for publication, so send high-resolution digital images saved to at least a 5x7 format. The general rule of digital photography is that you can always size down an image, but you can never size it up without sacrificing image quality. If you send images as attachments via e-mail, compress them. Too many photos at too high a resolution to e-mail? Let me know, and I'll give you our FTP site information.
