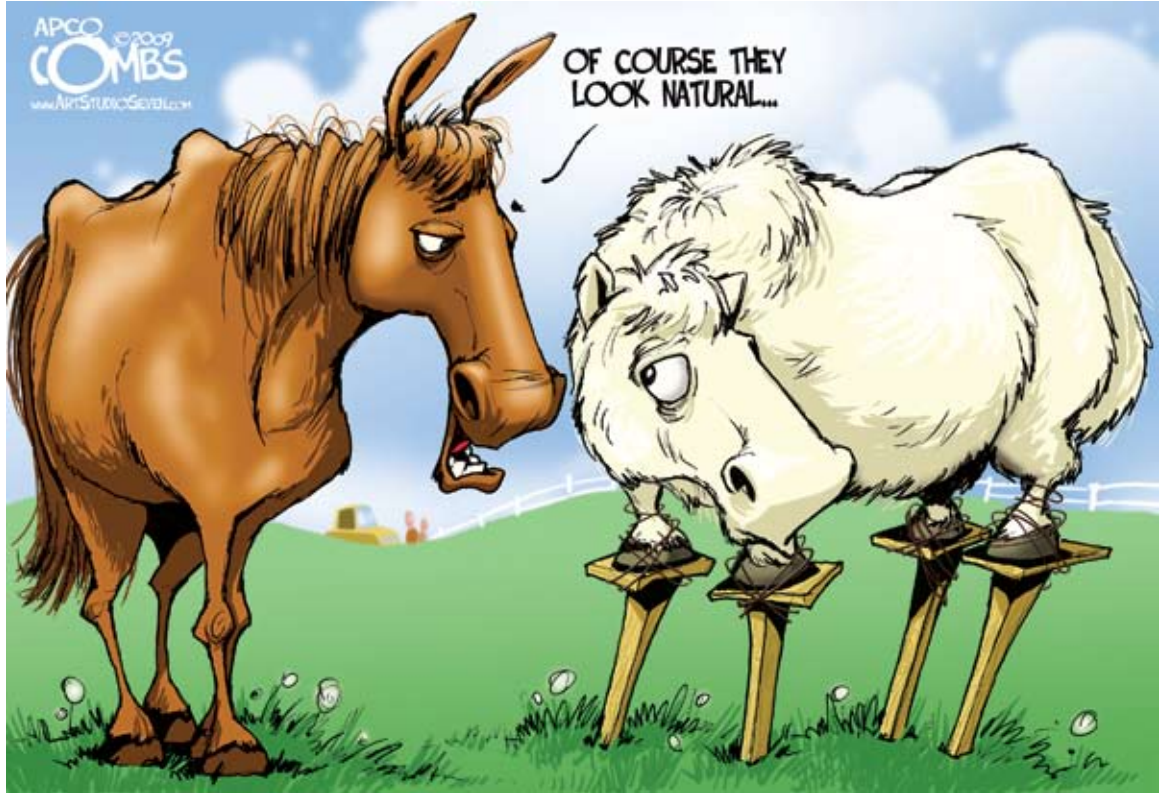

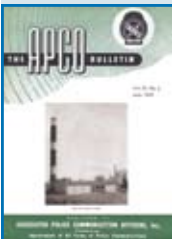

In “Where To Shop,” April *PSC*, p. 46, the Web site for **Ideal Seating** was incorrect. It should have been listed as www.idealseating.com.

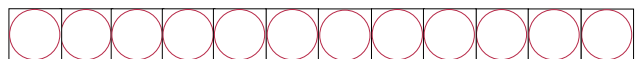
